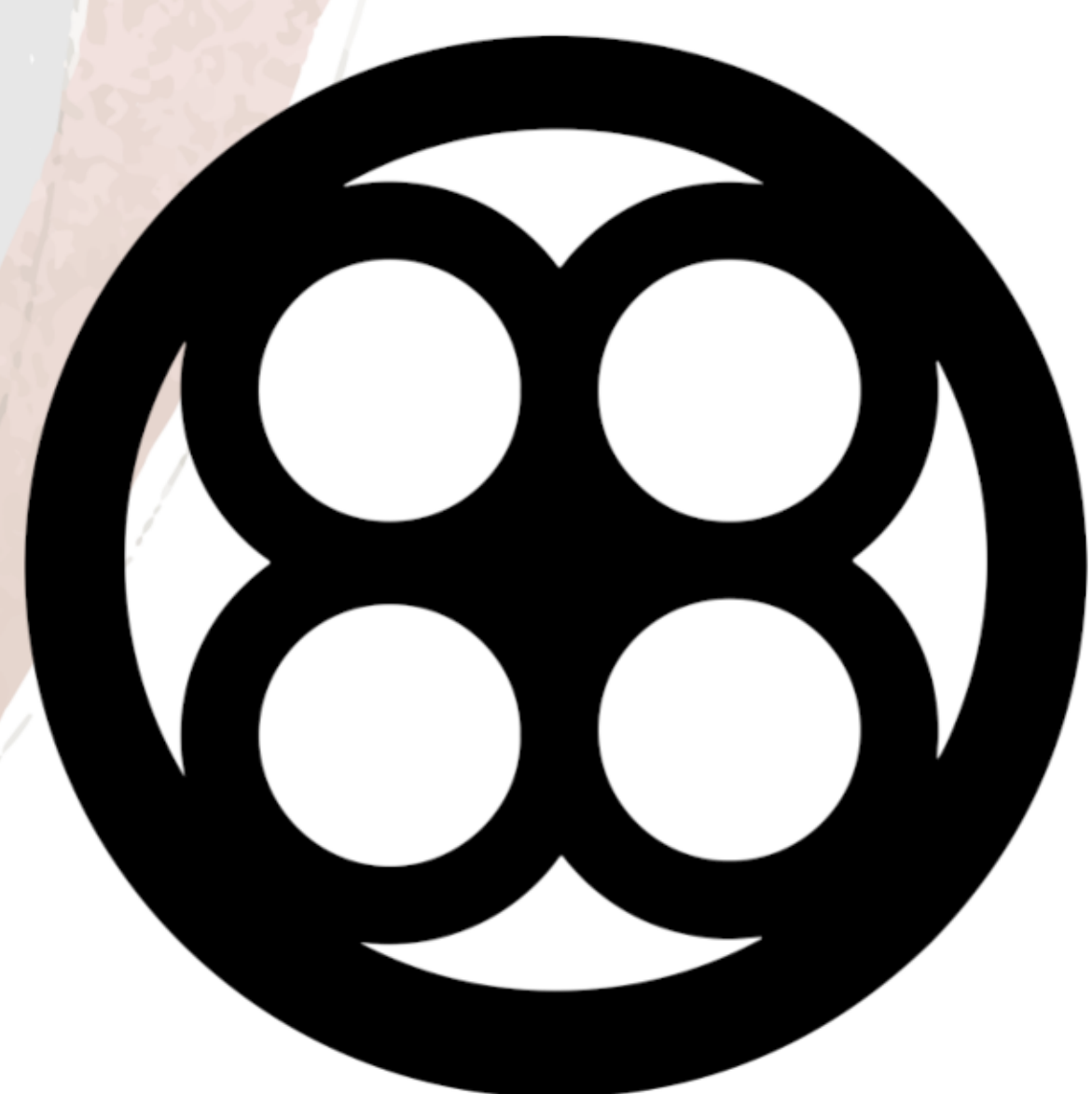

Being a dyslexia friendly library is about making sure we are providing access and support to children and young people with dyslexia and their families.

Through the library you have access to:

- Phonics/decodable readers
- Hi-lo books (high interest, low reading level)
- Books with dyslexia-friendly font and layout
- Talking books
- Graphic novels
- Online resources which are able to be tailored to make reading easier
- The C-Pen, a reader pen designed to support students reading

There's a dyslexia information hub at the Lismore Pop-Up Library where you can access brochures, reference, and parenting books, as well as samples from our dyslexia friendly collections.
