All students have their list of topics to choose from and they are given time during class but I would strongly recommend assistance from home.

All parents are invited to come to our in-school public speaking comp, which will be held on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> September commencing at 10am. Cath Marshal, relieving principal of Nimbin Central School will be adjudicating. This will only involve those stage 2 and stage 3 students who have elected to compete. All students will be giving a speech in front of their class earlier in that week.
